Dear Families:

As part of our school-wide reading initiative to build life-long readers and increase students' vocabulary and comprehension skills, your child is expected to read throughout the summer.

Your child should read **one** novel/book within his/her ZPD level and complete **5 hours of I-Ready Reading** (Deadline for I-Ready is August 11, 2017).

Your child can choose any book, however, we have a selected reading list as a guideline, which can be found on our summer reading website: <http://ppcessummerreading.weebly.com/>. After reading the book, your child must choose a performance task project listed on the summer reading website. Each one of these projects is designed to encourage your child to think critically about the books read, as well as to spark his/her creativity and individuality. **Due to the Accelerated Reader philosophy, you child will not be allowed to take an Accelerated Reader Test on the book chosen until the school year begins. Accelerated Reader will NOT be available at the local library as in years past.**

Projects are due August 25, 2017. Your child will receive **one participation letter grade in Reading for the first quarter** and a **homework pass** if he/she completes.

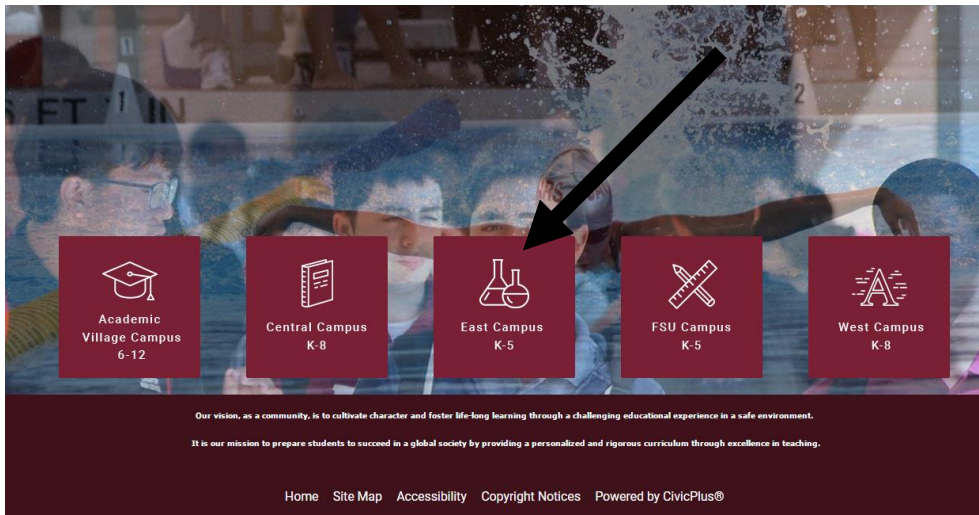
